Professor Dr Liu Ching-K uan, Taiwan

Dr Liu graduated from the Kaohsiung Medical University (KMU) of Taiwan in 1982. He went on train as a neurologist, and was made an Associate Professor at the KMU in 1986. From 1988-90 he worked as a clinical instructor of Neurobehavioral Program at the UCLA School of Medicine, and as a Fellow Physician of EEG and Clinical Neurophysiology at the Harbor-UCLA Medical Center, USA. In 1995 he was invited as a visiting Associate Professor of Neurology at the Reed Neurological Research Center, UCLA School of Medicine. He was made a full Professor and chairman of Neurology of KMU in 2000 and was later promoted to Dean of Infotech of KMU in 2002, vice superintendent of KMUH in 2006, and the Superintendent of Kaohsiung Municipal Hsiao-Kang Hospital in 2009. He was elected as president of Taiwan Dementia Society in 2006 and president of Taiwan Neurological Society in 2007. Currently, he is the President of KMU. He has been involved in numerous dementia related studies and clinical drug trials and had published 95 referred papers and 146 conference papers.
