Poster Abstract Submission & Guidelines 17th ASAD 2023

- All abstracts must be submitted and presented in clear English with accurate grammar and spelling of a quality suitable for publication.
- All abstracts must not exceed 500 words (does not include the title, author's details, or references). A table or figure will count as 150 words.
- The presenting author's name must appear first in the list of authors.
- There is no limit to the number of poster abstracts you may submit.
- Abstracts must be submitted online via the website only and received by the announced deadline.
- Poster presenters must be registered as participants and present at the venue to receive a certificate of appreciation at the end of the session
- Submission of an abstract acknowledges your acceptance for the abstract to be published in the official Congress publications.
- Abstracts must be original and must not be or have been published or presented at any other international meeting before the Congress.
- Instructions for preparing presentations (the poster size and presentation time) will be available on the Congress website.

Poster abstract submissions must be structured with the following :

- 1. Background
- 2. Method
- 3. Results
- 4. Conclusion
- 5. Keywords Mandatory to include three

Poster Award Rules

The poster presentation will be conducted in person. Three awardees will be selected based on experts' scores. Names of awardees will be announced at the closing of the ASAD conference, and each will receive award certificates and prizes (1st place: USD 300; 2nd place: USD 200; 3rd place USD 100). The fourth and fifth winners will be awarded if suitable candidates are selected. If there are no qualified candidates, some or all unfilled spots may be vacated. Those who get the young researcher award won't attend the poster award simultaneously.



Eligibility & award rules for the Young Investigator Award of the 17th International Congress of Asian Society Against Dementia (17th ASAD)

Background:

The Young Investigator Award encouraged early-career researchers to engage in dementia-related research.

Eligibility and Requirements:

This award is granted to young investigators who are early career researchers aged 45 or under at the time of application.

Award Rules:

- Applicants for the Young Investigator Awards must submit a brief CV and an abstract of their dementia-related research to the 17th ASAD via the conference website. No proprietary or confidential information should be included in the application.
- The candidates will be judged by experts in two stages. In the first stage, the experts will review the abstract submissions and select the best ten, and the remainder will be scheduled and informed via email as contestants in the poster presentation. In the second stage, the selected candidates (young researchers) will be invited to give an oral presentation in English during the Young Researcher session at the 17th ASAD conference.
- The presentation will be conducted in person.
- All presenters will receive a certificate of appreciation at the end of the session.
- Three awardees will be selected based on experts' scores. Awardees will be announced at the end of the conference, and each will receive award certificates and prizes (1st place: USD 500; 2nd place: USD 300; 3rd place: USD 200).
- If there are no suitable candidates, some or all unfilled spots may be vacated.
